C&A has banned the use of PFCs since the 1 January 2015 across all product categories and regions as part of our commitment to the Zero Discharge of Hazardous Chemicals (ZDHC) by 2020.

The below list sets out those chemical products that have been approved by C&A as an alternative. Only these chemical products are allowed to be used a PFC-free substitutions.

C&A has already tested, along with chemical suppliers and manufacturers, the chemical performance of the below listed alternatives, however, you are reminded that further tests may be needed to ensure all C&A requirements are met.

C&A retains no specific preference for the approved alternatives listed below. You recommended to conduct your own trial runs.
